GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOL NURSING

This new edition provides a more practical, accessible guide that better reflects the school nursing process of assessing a student and then determining the best course of action. We hope the school nurse will find the Assessment and Management Charts in section 9 most useful.

We have remained true to our original intention of providing a resource to promote consistency of practice within the school nursing profession and within school health care facilities. Again, the primary focus is child and adolescent health, but there is also significant attention paid to issues affecting school staff including legal obligations, standards of professional conduct and practical advice on equipping and maintaining a school health centre.

Although this resource is chiefly for NSW based school nurses, we recognise that these guidelines will have practical applications for nurses working in other states and territories. However we stress that the legal obligations and procedural information may differ from those of other states and territories.

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
